

Hilltop Tuition and Participation Requirements 2016-2017

Monthly Tuition for Families Planning to Work in the Classroom (Co-op)*

Program/Days	Work Requirements	Monthly Tuition
2 days (Seeds)	2 work days; 1 alt day per month	\$268
3 days (Sprouts)	3 work days; 1 alt day per month	\$345

Note: Families requiring a 5-day program may enroll concurrently in the Seeds and Sprouts program upon availability. The tuition for this option is \$595.

Monthly Tuition for Families NOT Planning to Work in the Classroom (non Co-Op)

Program/Days	Work Requirements	Monthly Tuition
2 days (Seeds)	None	\$381
3 days (Sprouts)	None	\$504
4 days (Blooms/Blossoms)	None	\$541

Note: Families requiring a 5-day program may enroll concurrently in the Seeds and Sprouts program upon availability. Price for this option is \$885.

Tuition Notes

*Upon availability, families may choose to "buy out" one or more of their co-op required days at the rate of \$46 per work day and \$21 per alternate day.

Families with two or more children simultaneously enrolled receive a 20% discount on the second and/or younger child and subsequent children.

The following additional Fees will be required which are nonrefundable:

- Registration fee: \$150 for returning students
\$175 for new students (including sibling)
- Materials fee: \$200

<p>Ways & Means (Fundraising) Obligation - Parents are required to participate in major fundraising events and contribute at least five hours towards the planning and execution of those events per school year.</p>	Yes	\$300 (\$60 per required hour)
<p>Auction Obligation– Each family is required to collect donations worth \$150 or more to be auctioned off at the school’s annual Auction Fundraiser. In addition, each family is required to sell a minimum number of tickets to the event (typically four tickets), and sell a minimum number of raffle tickets (typically \$20 worth).</p>	Yes	\$300
<p>Job Obligation - Parents are required to maintain a job or a committee position for the school year, i.e. Board member, librarian, secretary, fundraising committee.</p>	Yes	\$300
<p>Maintenance Obligations - Parents are required to perform two maintenance duties per school year, one of which is a maintenance job (such as painting or repair work), and the other of which is a scheduled Clean-Up Day.</p>	Yes	\$300 (\$150 for Cleanup Day; \$150 for maintenance job)
<p>General Meetings - Parents are required to attend monthly general meetings held the third Wednesday evening of each month from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. (parents not working in the classroom need only attend the three mandatory General Meetings held in September, January and April).</p>	No	
<p>Orientation - New parents working in the classroom are required to attend a one day (9am to 1pm) Classroom Mechanics Orientation session before they are scheduled to work in the classroom. All parents (working and non-working) are also required to attend a one day (9am to 1pm) Philosophy Orientation session typically held prior to the start of the school year.</p>	No
